- Some of the money provided by the funding is invested in the professional development of staff and as a result should enhance the quality of teaching for all children. The Real PE scheme and training has been implemented to create a consistent approach to teaching P.E. across the school. As a result, the quality of children's learning and development should be improved.
- Holy Trinity continues to buy in to the Leeds Sports Partnership which provides training and support for subject leaders and regular sporting activities for pupils.
- We have invested in quality PE equipment which will support high quality PE teaching over time.
- We intend to invest in 'Sporting Age' this year to track pupils progress in PE over time and to enable staff to implement support to meet the needs of individual learners.
